Job Title: Firefighter/Paramedic – F/T

Salary: - \$54,284 annually

Job Description:

Under general supervision the purpose of this position is to protect life and property from fire or fire related danger and provide emergency medical services. Employees in this classification perform skilled, protective, and lifesaving work. Position is responsible for extinguishing fires, rescuing persons and property from danger, performing emergency medical services, and performing salvage and related follow-up work. Performs related work as directed.

Note: Upon request, official job description of the duties required in this position is available in the Human Resources Department.

Qualification Requirements:

High School Diploma/GED, or other certificate of competency

Special Requirements:

- State Firefighter Certification
- EVOC Certification
- Valid State of Florida Driver's License
- State EMT Certification (within 3 months of date of hire)
- State Paramedic Certification
- Current AHA Advanced Cardiac Life Support Card
- Valid Broward Fire Academy County-Wide Physical Ability Test or equivalent (includes swim test)

Basis of Rating:

- 1) Review of application based on education, training, and experience as requested in the application; application reviews may include background checks and driving record.
- 2) Candidates with favorably reviewed applications will be scheduled for an oral interview to evaluate knowledge in this field of work. Results of the oral interview shall comprise 50% of the final score. A practical examination (mega-code) shall comprise the additional 50% of the final score. Both scores combined shall comprise the total final score based on 100%. However, to qualify to be examined through the practical portion, the candidate must pass the oral interview with a minimum score of 70%. The practical examination must also be passed with a 70% score for final qualification. The rule of three scores will then be applied for interviews for candidates who have met the qualification requirements and passed the examination process.
- 3) Oral interviews and practical exams will be given quarterly as needed with the results posted in a "rolling eligibility list" which will be updated at the completion of each examination process; candidates who successfully pass the complete examination will be added to the list and ranked according to their final scores; those candidates added to the current list and score higher than a candidate already on the current list may be placed ahead of those candidates already on the list; no one candidate may take the test more than once during any 12 month period and each candidate who successfully passes the examination process may remain on the list for no more than one year, unless the list is extended for a maximum of one additional year.

Eligible fourth semester paramedic students with a valid Florida EMT certification and valid Florida Firefighter Certification may submit an application and proceed through the examination process, but will not be added to the hiring list until all certifications are submitted; the time of eligibility for hire will be from the date of the examination.
