## UTILITY RECONNECTION/DISCONNECTION

If water service is disconnected for non-payment, a disconnection/reconnection service charge of \$50.00 will be applied to your next bill. Payments to reconnect service must be received by 6:00 pm on the same day. Payment received after 6:00 pm will be reconnected by the end of the next business day.

## CHECKING WATER LEAKS

Water leaks can be costly to a homeowner; your eyes and ears can easily see or hear some leaks. The most common leak is the toilet. It can leak up to an average of 22 thousand gallons.

## ADJUSTMENTS

The City of Lauderhill does not give credit/adjustments for toilets or faucet damage. If you find that you have a leak on your property the City of Lauderhill can help alleviate a portion of the wasted sewer by giving one leak adjustment per calendar year, if applicable. The customer must provide a copy of plumber's receipt for the repairs. This should include a description of the problem and the date of the repair. We will then use a six months prior average to calculate the adjustment amount.
