

NOTICE OF FUNDING STATE HOUSING INITIATIVES PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (SHIP) CITY OF LAUDERHILL

City of Lauderhill has been awarded State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Program funds from the State of Florida in the amount of \$ 94,065 for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 to provide affordable housing assistance to low, very low, and moderate households in the City of Lauderhill. The City of Lauderhill has allocated Special Needs Program funding in the amount of \$ 18,813 for FY 2013-2014 to be administered to qualified residents.

City of Lauderhill will use at least 20% of the allocation of SHIP funds for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 for special needs households as defined in 420.0004(13), F.S. through approved strategies or by incorporating new strategies, prioritizing funding for persons with developmental disabilities as defined in s. 393.063 (9), Florida Statutes, with an emphasis on home modifications, including technological enhancements and devices.

Special needs groups are as follows: elderly, homeless, pregnant teens, persons with HIV/AIDS, victims of domestic violence, disabled, mentally ill, chemically dependent, developmentally disabled, and runaway/abandoned children.

These funds are available through awards made to ELIGIBLE residents who submit applications for eligible affordable housing assistance activities.

Applications for the FY 2013-2014 SHIP Housing Program(s) may be obtained and accepted by appointment after March 4, 2014 by contacting the City of Lauderhill BNE Division at 954-730-3036, 5581 West Oakland Park Blvd. Lauderhill, FL 33313.
