NEWS RELEASE - COVID-19 (Coronavirus) #4 **City of Lauderhill Making Changes Where Needed to Minimize the Spread of COVID-19.**

Lauderhill, FL - March 18, 2020 – 6:00 PM – The City of Lauderhill’s Administrative Staff continues to work with County, State, and Federal Agencies to do our part in minimizing the spread of the COVID-19 Virus.

All City restaurants, bars, pubs, and nightclubs were given a copy of the Governor’s Executive Order #20-68.

All known public gatherings, meetings, and programming remain suspended until further notice. City Parks remain open, but Park Buildings are all closed. Garbage, recycling, and bulk will be picked up as regularly scheduled. Community Shuttles are running. Our next City Commission Meeting scheduled for March 30, 2020 is pending.

City Hall is operating out of a temporary **Remote Business Center immediately adjacent to City Hall**. The **Remote Business Center (RBC)** hours are Monday-Thursday, 7:30 AM – 6:00 PM. The RBC is accepting Building Permits, Utility Payments, and Certificates of Use. Although the City will not be turning water off for the next 30 days, we encourage customers to pay online or at TD Bank (7345 W. Oakland Park Boulevard.) Customers can place non-cash utility payments in the Drop Box at City Hall. In addition, the RBC will notify all permit holders when to pick up approved permits.
