## **NEWS RELEASE - COVID-19 (Coronavirus) #5** **City of Lauderhill Scales Back to Minimize the Spread of COVID-19.**

*Lauderhill, FL - March 19, 2020 – 6:00 PM* – The City of Lauderhill’s Administrative Staff and Emergency Operations Officials, in the interest of the health and safety of staff and residents, will scale back City operations to Public Safety (Police and Fire) Personnel and essential staff after close of business today. City Hall and all Administrative Offices, including the temporary Remote Business Center (RBC) will close at 6:00 PM today until further notice. The reopening of any City Offices will be considered on a week-to-week basis.

The City Commission will meet on Monday, March 23, 2020 at 10:00 AM in the Commission Chambers. This is a Special Meeting called only to discuss how the COVID-19 virus is affecting the operations and residents of the City. The meeting will be televised live on Comcast channel 78.

All City bars, restaurants, pubs, and nightclubs were given a copy of the Governor’s Executive Order #20-68. For more information on these requirements and mandates, see <https://www.lauderhill-fl.gov/dbprfaq> from the Department Of Business & Professional Regulation.

City Parks will remain open, but only until 8:00 PM. All Recreation Facilities remain closed. Garbage, recycling, and bulk pick up are on schedule, and the City Bus Shuttles are still running. The City Clerk’s office will not be accepting public records requests while closed.

Places of worship are being encouraged to stream services in order to avoid gatherings of more than 10 guests.

The City of Lauderhill Utilities Division suspended utility cutoffs until further notice. However, we are still accepting payments online at <https://mypayments.bill2pay.com/client/laudershill>.

During this time of emergency, Building Permits will proceed on an emergency basis only, such as replacing air conditioners, hot water heaters, roof repairs, etc. When City Hall/RBC reopens, permits will need to be submitted within 24 hours.
