Lauderhill, FL - March 27, 2020 – 5:00 PM – The City of Lauderhill is working with Federal, State, County and Municipal entities in the region to ensure the many Orders and Declarations intended to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 are applicable, enforceable, and most importantly effective.
