NEWS RELEASE - COVID-19 (Coronavirus) #14 **City of Lauderhill Adopts Our Own Safer at Home Order SOE #20-05 in Support of Broward County Emergency Order #20-03.**

Lauderhill, FL - March 28, 2020 – 5:00 PM – The Interim City Manager has adopted a [City of Lauderhill “Shelter in Place” and “Safer at Home” order](#) to further limit the potential community spread of COVID-19. Lauderhill’s [SOE #20-05](#) will go into effect on Monday, March 30, 2020 at 12:01 am.

The City of Lauderhill’s newest order specifically provides clarifications not yet clearly defined in orders previously set forth by the State and County. Travel is limited to the public **unless** engaging in business with essential businesses (*defined by Broward County Emergency Orders [#20-01](#), [#20-02](#), and [#20-03](#)*), traveling for emergency assistance, personal support activities, work in support of essential businesses, outdoor recreational activities, religious activities, and work being done in/for government, utility, and emergency services. Limitations on gatherings and social distancing requirements should still be observed while participating in any of the exceptions.

[SOE #20-05](#) also further identifies drive-in theaters and community pools as locations that must close to limit the spread of the virus. Finally, the [SOE #20-05](#) explains a resident’s home includes patios, porches, yards and driveways.
