#### **Broward Health COVID-19 Mobile Testing Site to Open in Lauderhill at Central Broward Park**

Broward Health will be opening a **COVID-19 Mobile Testing Site** on Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at 1:00 PM at the Central Broward Park & Broward County Stadium. The address is 3700 NW 11 Place, Lauderhill, FL 33311.

This appointment-only drive through testing site requires you have a prescription for the COVID-19 Test. Appointments can be made by calling 954-320-5730. In addition, you must come to your appointment in a car, with your prescription, and photo identification. Test results should be available in 5 to 7 days.

The Broward Health Mobile testing location is brought to you by Broward Health, in partnership with the Urban League, Broward County, Broward County Mayor Dale V.C. Holness, the Broward County Parks Department, Broward Sheriff’s Office, the City of Lauderhill, Lauderhill Police & Fire Departments, and Lauderhill Mayor Ken Thurston.
